- ❑ The School of Political and Social Sciences has a **long tradition**. One of the first Schools to be established at UCSC from its establishment in **1921**.
- ❑ The School is based on the principles of: common good, human dignity solidarity and subsidiarity.

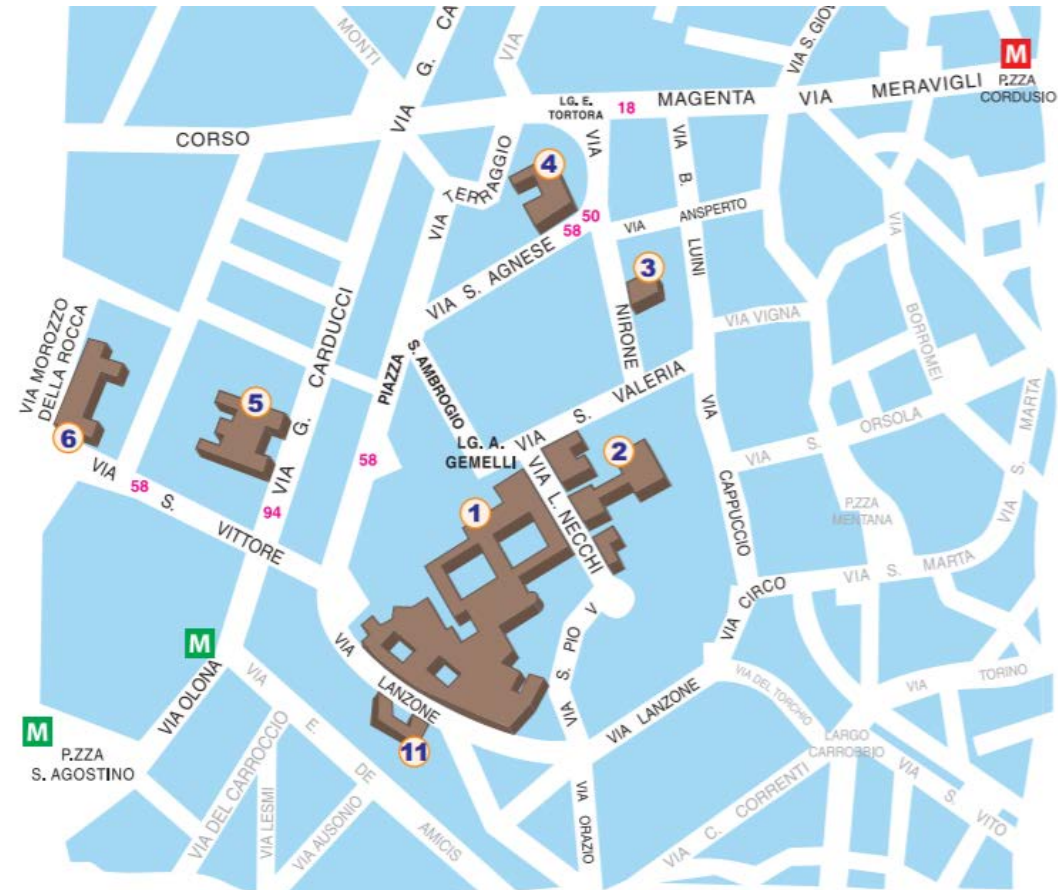
