Global Bachelor's Degree in International Relations

London School of Economics & Political Science

Benefit from two international placements thanks to our mobility agreements with universities worldwide. In your third year, you will be able to study at prestigious universities in Europe, the Americas or Asia. In your fourth year, as a Global student in International Relations, you will study at exclusive and world-renowned destinations such as the London School of Economics and Political Science.

Mandatory internship

You will undertake an internship in a public or private institution such as the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, a Spanish Embassy, a European Union Institution, a cooperation organization or an international foundation. You will have the chance to put into practice what you have learned and to strengthen skills such as teamwork, leadership or adaptability.

100 % international environment

Be international from the very first moment, inside and outside the classroom. Share learning experiences with students from other countries and with professors with extensive international experience that will bring you closer to the different professional dimensions in the international arena. Join the UEM's International Relations Club (IRClub), which brings together students interested in international relations and international affairs, from a social, professional and academic perspective. The IRCub carries out activities of all kinds that range from meetings with high-level personalities, organization of conferences and seminars, participation in MUNs in Spain and abroad, etc. Write and reflect on current affairs at the International Relations Observatory, our digital magazine dedicated to the analysis and research on international affairs. Students, professors and experts in International Relations come together in this university forum to discuss and inform on issues of global relevance.

Methodology: challenge based school

Experience our **Challenge Based Learning** methodology and learn how to professionally interact with the different agents that comprise the international context: states, public and private institutions, multinational companies, international organizations, NGOs, etc. Attend seminars with security and defense specialists, experts in global economics and Diplomats, and visit international organizations and strategic spaces for the understanding of International Relations. 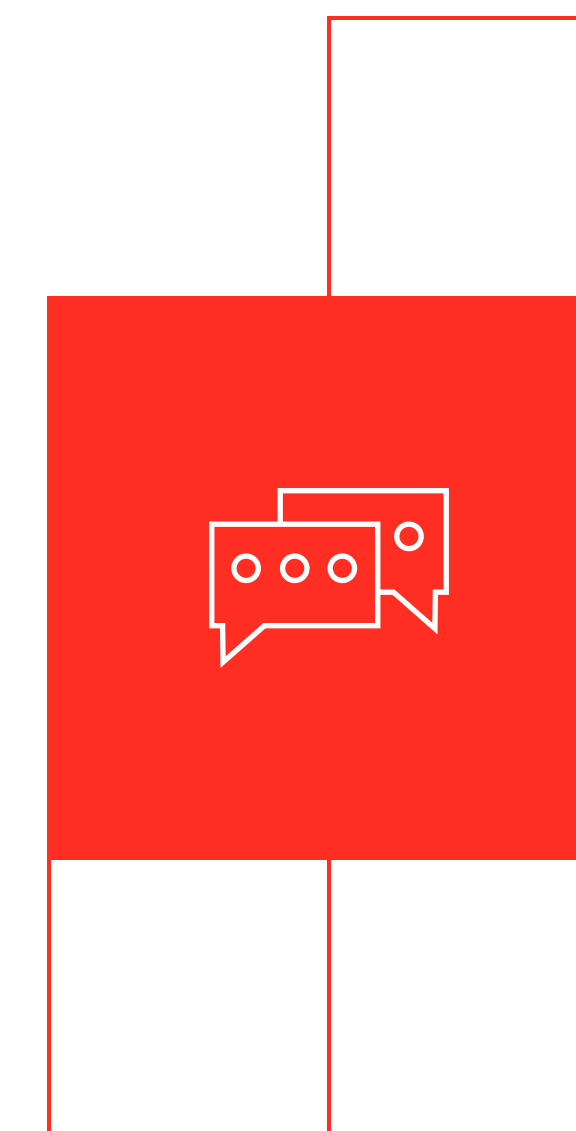

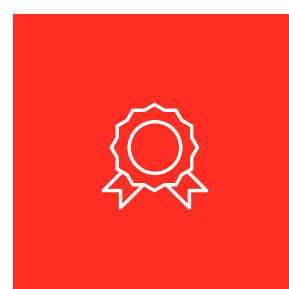

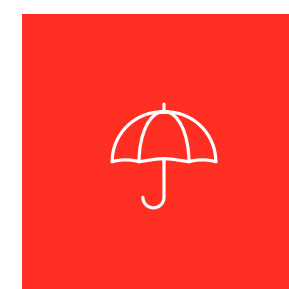

Admissions Process

Documentation

To start the admissions process, reserve an appointment at: universidadeuropea.com or by calling (+34 917 407 272).

After getting more information, you must submit the required documentation:

- Passport.
- Payment of the admissions fee on or before the day of your appointment.

What does the entrance exam involve?

- Test to evaluate competencies and skills.
- Language assessment test.
- Motivational survey.

When will you know if you've been admitted?
